Rules: The following rules apply to this festival:

1. Last year's winners **may** enter competitively.
2. Students must perform from memory.
3. A published copy of the music must be presented to the judge. **Measures must be numbered.** Students without music will not be eligible for an award. Those presenting photocopied music must submit the appropriate form to the Chair prior to the performance.
4. Age is determined as of the day of the event.
5. All compositions must be original—no arrangements, excerpts or unauthorized transcriptions may be submitted.
6. Time limits will be strictly enforced.
7. Repertoire may not be changed after the deadline.
8. **Students must stay for the entire recital in order to be eligible for an award.** Please plan accordingly.
