**Eligibility:** Students age 9 and above, as of the day of the event.

**Rules:** The following rules apply to both **Part A** and **Part B, whether competitive or noncompetitive:**

1. Solo works must be performed from memory.
2. A published copy of the music must be presented to the adjudicator.
3. Each student must provide his/her own accompanist.

**Repertoire:** **Part A: Classical Voice**

Voice solo: art songs and arias.  
Songs must contrast in either period or style; at least one must be in a foreign language.

**Part B: Popular Voice**

Voice solo: musical theater, popular songs, country and folk style.  
Songs must contrast in tempo and style.

**Time Limits:** The following time limits are for both **Part A** and **Part B, competitive or noncompetitive:**

<b>Ages 9 through 16</b>	<b>2 songs</b>	<b>8 minutes</b>
<b>Ages 17 through 20</b>	<b>2 songs</b>	<b>10 minutes</b>
<b>Ages 21 and over</b>	<b>2-3 songs</b>	<b>15 minutes</b>
