- 2. Written recommendation of the MSMTA teacher.
- 3. List of student's musical accomplishments, including the following: participation in official MSMTA competitions, events, and programs; participation in musical events in the community or religious organization as a soloist or group member; paying instrumental jobs or teacher experiences.
- 4. Student essay of 500 words explaining the student's interest in studying music in college and musical goals.
- 5. The committee will meet and select awardees by June 15.
